Subject: Approval of security screen

Dear Hussan,

Following on from your recent demonstration of the cab safe screen I can confirm that Sefton Council will permit the installation of such screens into private hire and hackney carriage non-metropolitan type vehicles providing that:

1. No screen may be fitted which prevents a driver from, in the event of an emergency, being able to exit from either the nearside or offside of a vehicle and;
2. The word cab in the trade name "cabsafe" is in no way displayed so as to create the impression that a vehicle is available for immediate hire;
3. No change in the displayed mounting specifications (as per your brochure) is made without seeking a further approval.

Allowing for those provisos I can confirm that Sefton Council has authorised me, under delegated powers, to approve your company's screens for installation in vehicles licensed by Sefton MBC for hire and reward and that this email should be retained as such authorisation and be produced, on request, to any

proprietor thinking of purchasing such a screen.
